

## Positions for election in District 14

The Nominating Committee shall secure nominations and prepare a slate of candidates, if possible two or more candidates for each district office that is to be filled at that election and of five nominees for the District Nominating Committee. (District 14 Rules of Procedure)

### A. District Board

- Governor
- Lt. Governor
- Treasurer
- Area Director (for each area)
- Vice Area Director (for each area)

#### Prerequisites (ZI Bylaws Art. XIV):

Each elected officer shall be a member of a club, shall have served at least two years in an elected club office and/or have been a district committee chair. The governor, lieutenant governor and area directors shall have served at least one year as club president. An elected officer shall hold no other elective position at district level. An elected vice area director shall meet the same prerequisites as the area director. Area directors and/or vice area directors shall be elected by the delegates from the clubs in that area.

No member who has served previously as an elected officer is eligible to serve in the same office again except that the treasurer and the area directors are eligible to be elected to a second term which may be either consecutive or not. An officer who has served more than half a term is considered to have served a full term in that office.

### B. Nominating Committee

- 3 members to be elected

#### Prerequisites (ZI Bylaws Art. XIV):

Each member of the Nominating Committee shall be a member of a club, shall have served at least two years in an elected club office and have served in an elected or appointed capacity at the district level.

The member receiving the highest number of votes shall be the chair of the committee. No member of the committee shall be eligible for nomination at the district level of Zonta International while serving on the committee.

### C. Auditors

- 2 auditors

#### Prerequisites (ZI Bylaws Art. XIV):

At the close of the biennium and at any other time determined to be in the best interest of the district, the district board shall cause the district financial records to be examined (audited, reviewed or compiled) by certified/chartered public accountants or by a qualified individual independent of the district board. The examined financial statement and report shall be presented at the district conference.

#### District 14 Rules of Procedure:

At the end of the second fiscal year the financial report of the whole biennium has to be audited by the elected Auditors by July 15. The audited financial report must be presented to the past Governor by August 1. The elected Auditors audit the books independently and present their written report to the District voting body. The Auditors will be elected on the proposal of the Nominating Committee at the District business meeting for voting for the following biennium.
